Our goal is teach the basics of plant tissue culture using a microwave and supplies found in your kitchen and classroom.

In this all-day workshop, you will make your own media, assemble a “clean box”, disinfect and culture plant leaves, axillary buds and seeds, and discuss trouble shooting and resources.

You will take home sample cultures that you create in class plus a handout with basic instructions and FREE samples to use at home.

All media and materials for the workshop will be provided. No prior knowledge required – only an interest in plants!
